REGULATION 201:2: Additional mandatory requirements for newly admitted lawyers.

By the end of a newly admitted lawyer's first two-year compliance period after admission to the Bar of New Jersey, the newly admitted lawyer must have satisfied fifteen of his or her required credit hours in any five of the following nine subject areas:

- New Jersey basic estate administration
- New Jersey family law practice
- New Jersey landlord/tenant practice
- New Jersey basic estate planning
- New Jersey real estate closing procedures
- New Jersey municipal court practice
- New Jersey civil or criminal trial preparation
- New Jersey trust and business accounting
- New Jersey law office management
